

Experiential Learning School Road Show



What is involved?

Our Mobile Climbing Wall will be set up and ready for use <u>at your school</u> between 10:15am and 12.15pm (2 sessions) along with our dedicated staff team.

Each session lasts 1 hour and a maximum of 16 children per session can take part. Therefore 32 children can take part over the 2 hour period we have allocated.

Each 1-hour session involves coaching in climbing technique and skilled experiential learning facilitation by our dedicated staff team including taking personal responsibility and importance of self-belief, trust in oneself and others, importance of working together as a team and on-going reflection.

The Mobile Climbing Wall is a 6 meter (20-ft) high artificial rock-climbing wall mounted on a trailer. Climbers are attached to a **state-of-the-art safety cable system** that slowly lowers' them safely to the ground after each climb.

The unique multi-faceted design allows up to four people to simultaneously climb and there are a total of 16 climbing routes/options on the wall of varying difficulty to suit all abilities.

Who can take part?

It is suitable for children from 8 years old to 15 years old including the disabled.
